MUSIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAM for Stokes County students. Giving over 800 elementary school children from South Eastern Stokes county an appreciation for music. Global Trekkers work in collaboration with the Stokes County Arts Council and Winston-Salem Symphony Orchestra.

Each week is different but you are guaranteed to have fun!

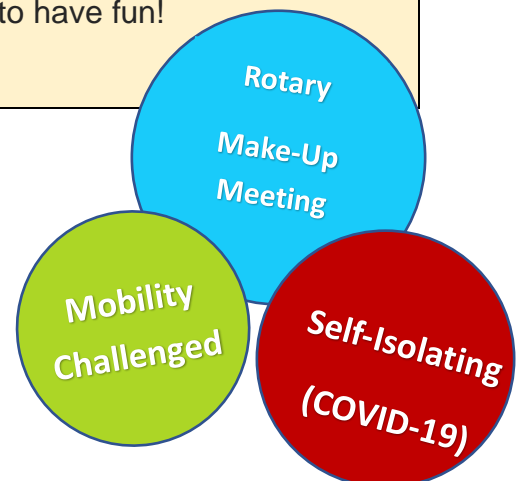
