About the "Trees for Tributaries" Project



The Trees for Tributaries Project

The Trees for Tributaries, a New York State Department of Conservation (DEC) program, provides trees and shrubs to plant along creeks, streams, and rivers across New York. These buffers will help reduce bank erosion, increase flood protection, and control sediment deposition.

Where is the Susquehanna River?

The Susquehanna River, the longest river on the East Coast of the United States, begins its 444-mile southerly flow to the Chesapeake Bay at Havre de Grace, Maryland at the outlet of Otsego Lake in Cooperstown, New York. The Susquehanna and its tributaries in the states of New York, Pennsylvania, and Maryland drain over 27,000 square miles, contributing one-half of the freshwater flowing to the Chesapeake Bay.

Ecological Facts about this river?

The Susquehanna River is one of the oldest existing rivers in the world. Geologists estimate it predates the mountains through which it flows.

What is Rotary Global Trekkers involvement

In May 2023, volunteers planted trees: Black Willow, Nine Bark, Red Osier Dogwood, and Silky Dogwood on a small parcel of land bordering the Susquehanna River just below Otsego Lake. Last year, these volunteers planted over 200 trees along a nearby creek. Other members of Global Trekkers also participate in planting native trees and flora in their respective countries to help preserve the environment.

What is our fundraising goal?

The Rotary E-Club of Global Trekkers sells "Trees for Tributaries E-Certificates" @ US\$10* each. These E-Certificates will be emailed not posted. The goal of this fundraiser is to raise \$2,000 in contributions to support the service projects and work of the Global Trekkers in the Rotary year 2023-24.
